

## Cell Phone Usage Guidelines for all AFICE Students

If you arrive in the U.S. with your own cellphone, then arrangements should already be in place for your monthly bill to be paid for by your natural parents. At **NO TIME** should any cell phone bill be addressed to your host family, or any cell phone bill in your name and for your personal use sent to your host family address. All billing for your cell phone should be paid for via the online payment center through your cell phone carrier, and should be paid directly by you or your natural parents.

If you arrive in the U.S. and wish to purchase a cell phone, you must purchase one at **YOUR OWN EXPENSE**. Under **NO** circumstances are you to have your host parents purchase a phone for you, or have your host parents put you, the student, on their cell phone plan, FOR ANY REASON – NO EXCEPTIONS! If you have chosen to purchase a cell phone in the U.S., you should also purchase a PRE-PAID calling card. This allows you to purchase cell phone minutes monthly, at your own expense.

The host family is not required to purchase you a cell phone, put you on their cell phone plan, purchase a pre-paid calling card for you, or pay any portion of your cell phone bill.

You must follow host family rules in regards to cell phone time, which includes phone calls, texting, and data use. In order for you, the student, to properly bond with your host family, you need to keep contact with family and friends back home to a maximum of once every week. Constant communication with family members or friends back home be it calling or texting can be grounds to be expelled from the AFICE program.

## Computer Usage Guidelines for all AFICE Students

AFICE Students must abide by their host family rules as they apply to computer usage. School work and school study done on the computer should be completed before any non-academic computer use. Contact with natural family members and friends from back home, be it via Email, Skype, Facebook chat, or any instant message/chat should be limited to one hour, once a week. Spending too much time on the computer may be grounds to be placed on an AFICE Behavior Contract. Constant contact with family and friends from back home can be cause for termination from the program.
